For those who aspire to become profession dancers, we strive to be the solid foundation that makes it possible. Most importantly, however, we want each and every student to experience the joy and discipline of the performing arts, to improve their bodies and minds to the best of their abilities, and to feel good about themselves.

What we offer...

Ballet

It's what makes a dancer great and is considered to be the number one form of training. As members of the Cecchetti Council of America we are qualified to teach a graded method that is offered for ages 8 thru adult. Students taking a minimum of 2 hours a week and showing a mastery of their level of dance are encouraged (not required) to prepare for examinations. More advanced dancers taking a minimum if 3 hours a week may be allowed into pointe work if they meet certain criteria. Basic ballet and level 1 classes are hour per class. Ballet students working on levels 2 and up are required to attend at least 2 a week with each class lasting 1 and 1/2 hours.

It is strongly recommended that all ballet students take at least 2 hours a week as a minimum

Tap

Excellent for developing coordination and rhythm, this is a fun art form that provides quick gratification and feelings of accomplishment. Classes are 30 minutes to 45 minutes long, depending on the size of the class. For ages 8 and up.

Jazz

This style of dance should be in every dancer's vocabulary. We teach many styles of jazz starting with a hip-hop fun style, and progress to a Broadway styled class for the more experienced dancer. All students are encouraged to take an additional class in ballet to strengthen their technique, thus advancing quicker. Students 10 years and older are eligible for the Leaps and Turn class that is designed for jazz. Classes are 1 hour. For ages 9 and up.

Pointe

For the serious ballet student that has finished level 2 and has achieved proper body alignment and strength. Placement is by teacher recommendation, only. Class is one hour.

Contemporary

This hugely popular art form requires a solid ballet foundation and is only open to those students who have finished level 2 in ballet. Again, admittance into this class is by teacher evaluation. Class is 1 hour.

Tiny Dancer/Creative dance

Designed for little ones, ages 3+ to 4+, to help them develop coordination, motor and social skills while instilling the love of dance. It is a 30 minute class that meets once a week.

Combination Kids

Offered to ages 4+ thru 8, this is an outstanding introduction to dance for the young beginner and semi-beginner. It's a 45 minute lesson that meets once a week.

<u>Special 3 month courses in:</u> Acro-dance (for ages 7 thru teens) Adult ballet Hip-hop (3rd grade thru adult)

These classes are designed for anyone who has ever dreamed of dancing. Treat yourself to a unique and fun experience. Better yet, bring a friend!

Registration, tuition, and holidays:

Along with a registration form, you'll need to return a \$30.00 registration fee. It is non-refundable once your place in class is secure and non-transferable. Also, when class starts, payment for the first month is required by the first lesson. Tuition is due by the first of each month. Payments received after the 7th of the month will receive a late fee of \$10.00. We do not send out statements unless you are late.

Holidays will coincide with public school holidays at President's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Memorial Day. There is no deduction for months with holidays, nor is there additional charge for months with five lessons. There is no deduction for missed lessons. Lessons missed because of illness can be made up, provided there is a class available.
